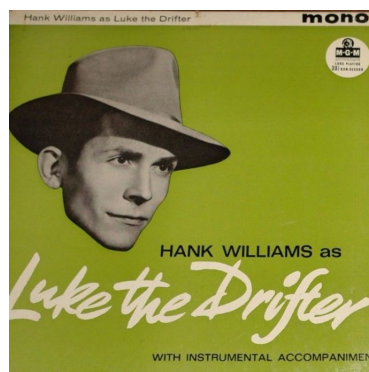


Hiram King Williams - Hank Williams – (born Sept. 17, 1923, Alabama – died Jan. 1, 1953, West Virginia) - recorded several songs from 1939-47 that never were released on 78s, but later on they were released on a cloud burst of LPs and CDs and many were included in the Complete Hank Williams Box Set from 1998. Concerning his life and legend, you can find it all in a number of books about him.

All of his 78s have been re-released on many, many LP's and CD's. ONLY the 78s are included in this discography. Hank Williams records on 78s have been released world wide and only a fraction is listed here (mostly UK)

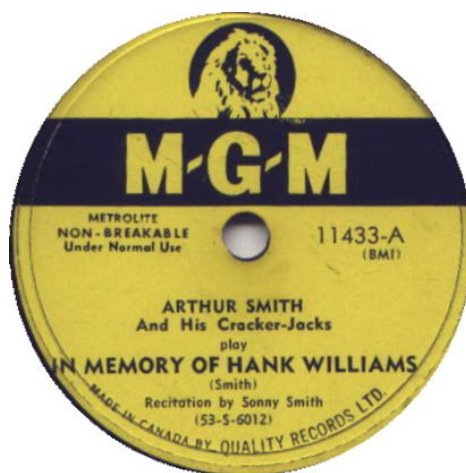
