John Conte - A crooner in the Italian style with lots of violins. He was married to the owner of Conte Records and subsidiary Chattahoochee Records – Ruth Conte – who also worked as producer on some of the first releases. That explains why he got so near to a microphone...

Leon did several sessions with artists released on the Chattahoochee label, and this could be on of them. Kim Fowley was the in-house producer for the label.
